## ABOUT JESUS

### 1. He is God's One and Only Son

a. John 1:14

- The glory seen is the glory of the one and only Son.

c. Philippians 2:5-11 Jesus emptied himself of his deity and became flesh. He died for us and was raised by God the Father. God then exalted him to the highest place and gave him a name above every name, that at his name every knee shall bow.

d. 2 Corinthians 8:9

a. Was born of the virgin Mary (Luke 1:26-28)

b. Jesus Died, was Buried, and Rose from the Dead

- Luke 24:6-7, One of the women at the empty tomb told the others to remember how he told them that the Son of Man must be crucified and on the third day be raised again.

- 1 Corinthians 15:3-4

- Christ died for our sins, was buried, and was raised on the third day. All of these things were done according to the \_\_\_\_\_.

c. Ascended into Heaven

- Luke 24:50-53

- Acts 1:9, Jesus was "*taken up before their very eyes.*"

d. Rules in Heaven on God's Right Hand

- Acts 2:34-36.

- Colossians 3:1
